The Magnet Foundation needs financial support and dedicated volunteers to achieve this mission. There is no better investment than your child's education!

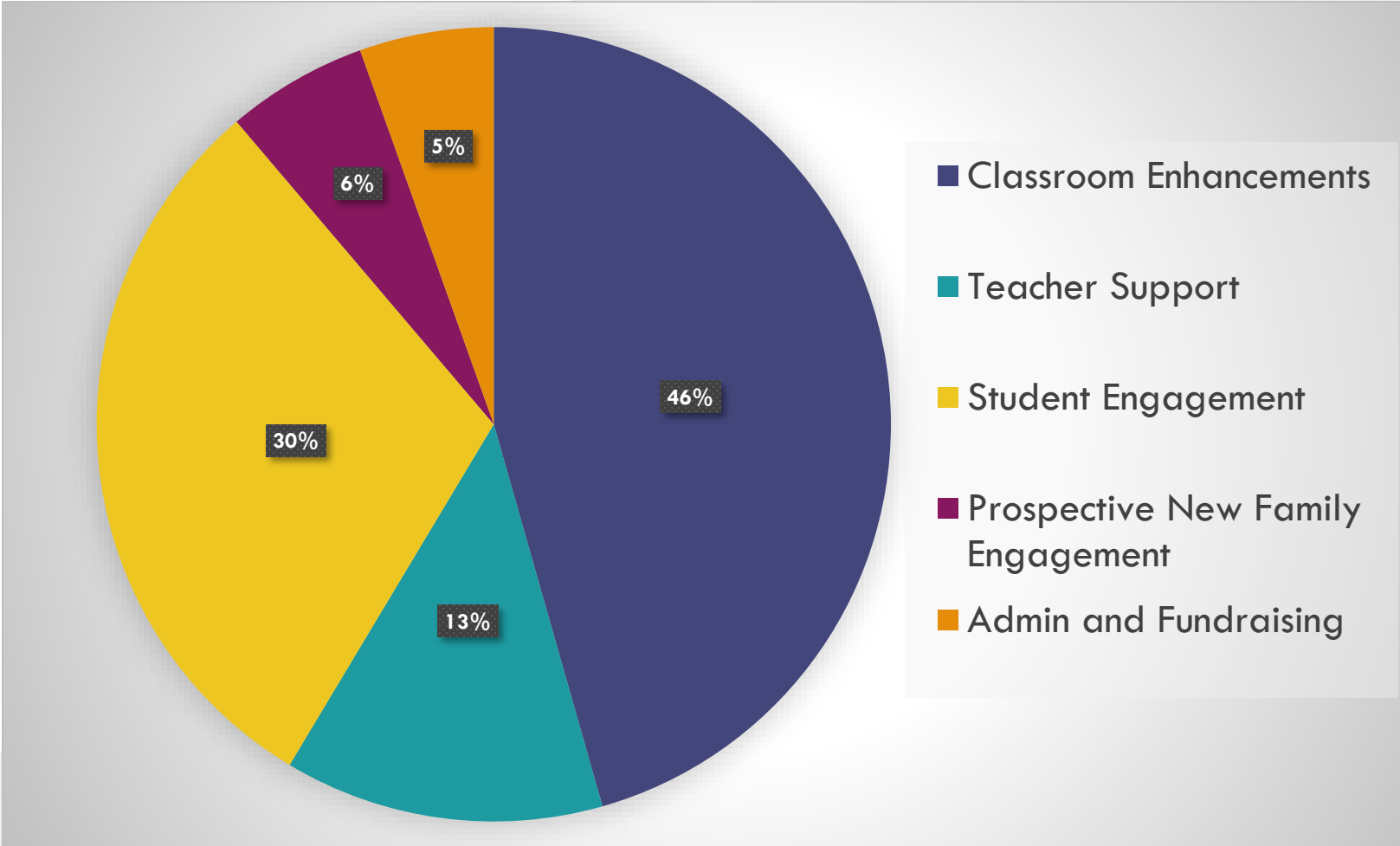

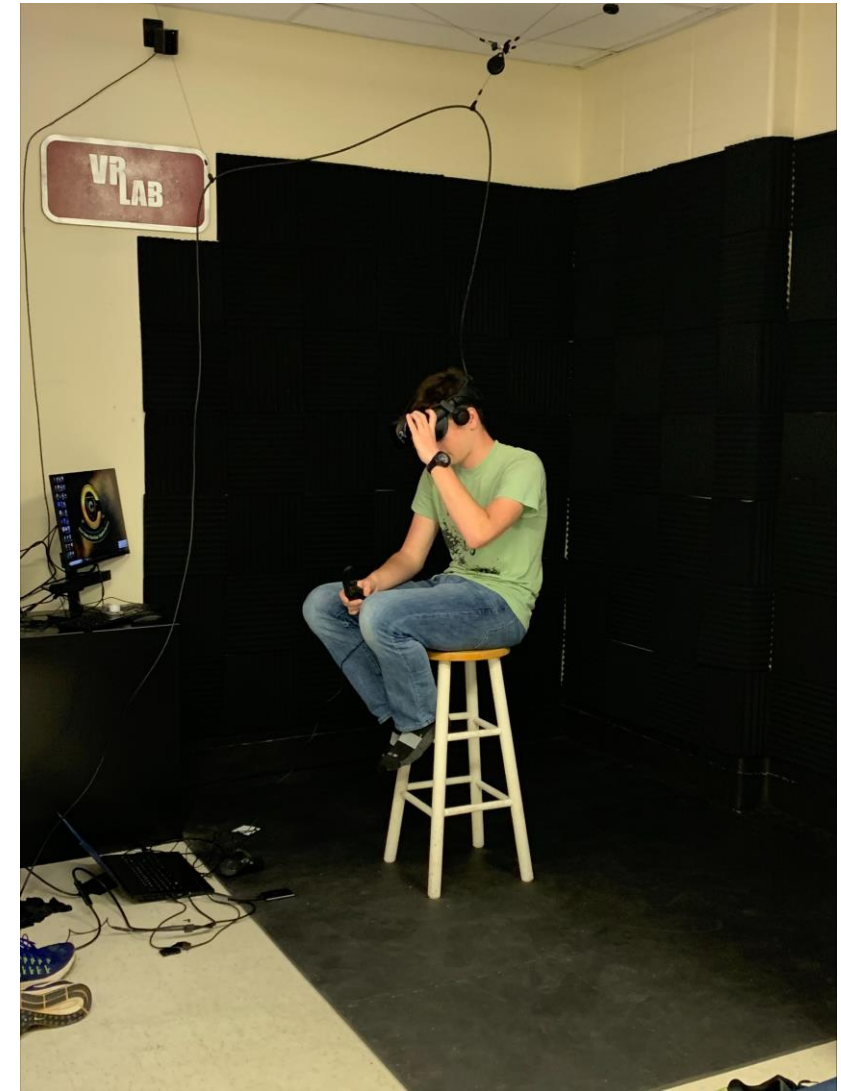
